What You'll Learn:

How You Learn:

The M.Ed. In Administration and Supervision is presented online over 20 months in an accelerated format. You'll take classes one at a time in 8 week blocks to allow intense study of each concept.

The degree program requires a total of 320 internship hours on the elementary, secondary, and central office levels; 120 of which are embedded in coursework. Students will be required to participate in Zoom conferences with the university supervisor.
